03 Do the verses from Ecclesiastes surprise you? What do you think its author means when they say there is nothing better than to "eat, drink, and find enjoyment in [your] toil"?

Diving deeper

Read the entirety of Ecclesiastes 1. Spend some time processing both what these verses would have meant in the time of Solomon, but also what they mean for us in the 21st century. Do a little research if you need to! Is there anything that feels particularly applicable to life today? What is it?
